

Interim Statement 3/2018
on the Investigation of Aircraft Serious Incident on China Eastern
Airlines Corporation Limited Airbus A321-211 Aircraft
(Registration Mark B-6366) on 24 May 2017

In accordance with the requirements of Annex 13 to the Convention of International Civil Aviation, an investigation is in progress to determine the circumstances and causes relating to the serious incident involving an Airbus A321-211 aircraft (registration mark B-6366) operated by China Eastern Airlines Corporation Limited which veered off Runway 25R after the aircraft landed at the Hong Kong International Airport on 24 May 2017.

Based on all collected evidence, the investigation team is analysing the information gathered in order to determine the circumstances and causes of the serious incident.

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
